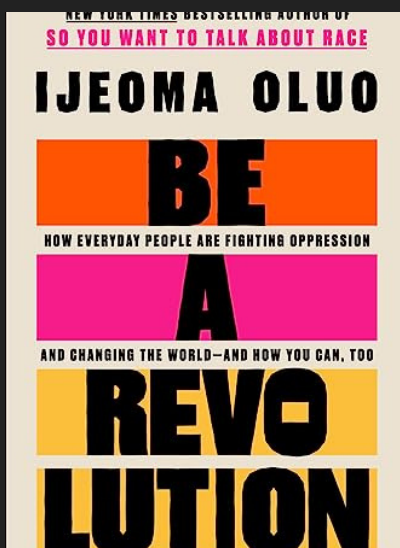


LOCALS CONFRONTING RACISM
