Summer Member Organizers

The MTA is looking for 100 members to reach out to fellow educators about what it means to be All In for their local and MTA and to educate parents and other community allies to help pass a ballot initiative in November that will end MCAS as a graduation requirement.

In July and August, MCAS Summer Member Organizers will canvass and phone other MTA members and voters to have conversations about MTA's support for a November ballot initiative that will eliminate using the MCAS as a graduation requirement. Membership SMOs will talk to non-members about the importance of joining their local and MTA. If selected, you will receive ongoing training in organizing, 1:1 conversations and other skills to help you be a successful organizer.

Minimum Qualifications:

- 1. Commitment to ending the MCAS graduation requirement.
- 2. Prior SMO or organizing experience preferred.
- 3. Strong interpersonal communication skills and ability to collaborate as a member of a team.
- 4. Self-motivated, with attention to detail and responsible follow-through
- 5. Personal transportation and valid driver's license

Duration:

Four to six weeks: July 15 -August 30

Compensation:

Lead Member Organizer: \$40 per hour, 30 hours per week – \$1200 per week. (LMOs will be selected from among SMO candidates.)

Summer Member Organizer: \$35 per hour, 25 hours per week – \$875 per week.
